



Impeachment Sentiments August 6, 2025. The Senate Vote

The above figure shows that for the day the senate voted to archive the articles of impeachment, there was an overwhelming 65% of positive sentiments. Suggesting that while the impeachment vote was not carried out, instead archived, there were more people happy to see the motion stay alive albeit not dead at the same time.

The above figure shows that selected negative sentiments on the archive vote only garnered less than 19% of all data on sentiments which is significantly less than positive sentiments. This suggests that either the sentiments were either negative because the senate voted to archive the articles instead of carrying on, or that the Senate did not choose to dismiss the complaint outright which was the wish of a group of senators during the vote.
